**Pre-conception communications shed light on our existence before development of first embryonic cell. Each soul not only seeks birth, it is aware of parents and interacts with them. The Jewish *Kabbalah* teaches that the creation of our life begins with parents' cognition of a child's soul image. If a model of the**

baby body which is to clothe the newly descended soul does not hover over nuptial bed, intercourse does not lead to conception.

Such courting relationships spark couples to have thoughts of babies. This reminds us of the Greek and Roman Cupid who fired golden-tipped arrows into the hearts of potential parents to trigger their falling in love. Perhaps the Cupid factor is responsible for millions of children coming into world.



Except for a few reports, our modern age has been slow to give attention to pre-conception intuition, visions, and dreams. One exception is Elisabeth Hallett's *Soul Trek*, which includes 37 stories of meeting a child prior to conception based on interviews with 184 mothers and fathers.

Another researcher, Sarah Hinze, explores pre-conception experiences in *Coming From the Light*, including her own: When Sarah entered her daughter's bedroom, a hallowed feeling came from a male presence who hovered angel-like

above seven-month-old Becky's crib. Becky cooed with joy and her face glowed as she kicked her feet and gazed upward at the invisible visitor. Sarah's spiritual ears heard the male visitor say, "Tell Mother I need to come now."

Professor Frank J. Seligson's book, *Oriental Birth Dreams*, reports pre-conception and pregnancy dreams from South Korean parents. The dream grandfather for example, appeared to a woman and advised, "If you desire a son, move to Seoul." Shortly after she followed his advice, a shepherd boy appeared in her dream, accompanied by a vague figure standing behind in the haze. The boy asked the woman, "Why are you fretting?" She explained her desire for a son. He asked, "What if I become your son? Ten months later, Han-jin was born. The second figure in the dream was born as his younger sister.
